Mr. STUMP introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee

A BILL

To clarify the effect on the citizenship of an individual of
the individual's birth in the United States.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. BASIS OF CITIZENSHIP CLARIFIED.**

4 In the exercise of its powers under section 5 of the
5 Fourteenth Article of Amendment to the Constitution of
6 the United States, the Congress has determined and here-
7 by declares that any person born after the date of enact-
8 ment of this Act to a mother who is neither a citizen or
9 national of the United States nor admitted to the United
10 States as a lawful permanent resident, and which person

1 is a citizen or national of another country of which either
2 of his or her natural parents is a citizen or national, or
3 is entitled upon application to become a citizen or national
4 of such country, shall be considered as born subject to the
5 jurisdiction of that foreign country and not subject to the
6 jurisdiction of the United States within the meaning of
7 section 1 of such Article and shall therefore not be a cit-
8 izen of the United States or of any State solely by reason
9 of birth in the United States.
