3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Medicare Equitable
- 5 Payment Enhancement Act of 2001".

SEC. 2. MODIFICATION OF CALCULATION OF MEDICARE IN PATIENT HOSPITAL WAGE INDEX.

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Effective with respect to cost reporting periods beginning on or after October 1, 2002, in 4 5 determining what proportion of operating costs of inpatient hospital services (as defined in section 1886(a)(4)6 7 of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1395ww(a)(4))) are 8 attributable to wages and wage-related costs, the Sec-9 retary of Health and Human Services shall exclude the following cost categories: 10

- 11 (1) "Professional fees".
- 12 (2) "Postal services".
- 13 (3) Under the cost category of "All other labor14 intensive", the following:
- 15 (A) "Business services".
- 16 (B) "Computer and data processing".
- 17 (C) "Other membership organizations".

18 (b) USE OF MORE RECENT DATA IN UPDATING THE 19 WAGE INDEX.—The Secretary of Health and Human 20 Services, in updating the factor (established by the Sec-21 retary) reflecting the relative hospital wage level in the 22 geographic area of a hospital compared to the national av-23 erage hospital wage level under the second sentence of sec-24 tion 1886(d)(3)(E) of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1395ww(d)(3)(E)) for a fiscal year, the Secretary shall use 25

- 1 data from the cost reports beginning during the third fis-
- 2 cal year that precedes the fiscal year involved.
