**AN ACT**

To amend the Act that established the Pu‘uhonua O  
Hōnaunau National Historical Park to expand the  
boundaries of that park.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Pu‘uhonua o  
5       Hōnaunau National Historical Park Addition Act of  
6       2002”.

1 **SEC. 2. ADDITIONS TO PU‘UHONUA O HŌNAUNAU NA-**  
2 **TIONAL HISTORICAL PARK.**

3 The first section of the Act of July 26, 1955 (69 Stat.  
4 376, ch. 385; 16 U.S.C. 397), is amended—

5 (1) by striking “That, when” and inserting the  
6 following:

7 “SECTION 1. (a) When”; and

8 (2) by adding at the end thereof the following  
9 new subsections:

10 “(b) The boundaries of Pu‘uhonua o Hōnaunau Na-  
11 tional Historical Park are hereby modified to include ap-  
12 proximately 238 acres of lands and interests therein with-  
13 in the area identified as ‘Parcel A’ on the map entitled  
14 ‘Pu‘uhonua o Hōnaunau National Historical Park Pro-  
15 posed Boundary Additions, Ki‘ilae Village’, numbered  
16 PUHO–P 415/82,013 and dated May, 2001.

17 “(c) The Secretary of the Interior is authorized to  
18 acquire approximately 159 acres of lands and interests  
19 therein within the area identified as ‘Parcel B’ on the map  
20 referenced in subsection (b). Upon the acquisition of such  
21 lands or interests therein, the Secretary shall modify the  
22 boundaries of Pu‘uhonua o Hōnaunau National Historical  
23 Park to include such lands or interests therein.”.

**1 SEC. 3. AUTHORIZATIONS OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

2        There are authorized to be appropriated such sums  
3 as may be necessary to carry out this Act.
