A BILL

To amend title 38, United States Code, to extend the Native American veteran housing loan pilot program, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Native American Vet-
5 erans Home Loan Act of 2001”.

1 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF NATIVE AMERICAN VETERAN HOUS-**
2 **ING LOAN PILOT PROGRAM.**

3 Section 3761(c) of title 38, United States Code, is
4 amended by striking “2001” and inserting “2005”.

5 **SEC. 3. AUTHORIZING THE USE OF CERTAIN FEDERAL**
6 **MEMORANDUMS OF UNDERSTANDING.**

7 Section 3762(a)(1) of title 38, United States Code,
8 is amended—

9 (1) by inserting “(A)” after “(1)”;

10 (2) by striking “; and” and inserting “; or”;

11 and

12 (3) by adding at the end the following:

13 “(B) the tribal organization that has jurisdic-
14 tion over the veteran has entered into a memo-
15 randum of understanding with any department or
16 agency of the United States with respect to direct
17 housing loans to Native Americans that Secretary
18 determines substantially complies with the require-
19 ments of subsection (b); and”.
