2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REAUTHORIZATION OF TANF SUPPLEMENTAL**
4 **GRANT FOR POPULATION INCREASES FOR**
5 **FISCAL YEAR 2002.**

6 Section 403(a)(3) of the Social Security Act (42
7 U.S.C. 603(a)(3)) is amended—

8 (1) in subparagraph (A)(ii), by striking “and
9 2001,” and inserting “2001, and 2002,”;

1 (2) in subparagraph (C)(iii), by striking “and
2 2001” and inserting “2001, and 2002”;

3 (3) in subparagraph (E)—

4 (A) by striking “appropriated for” and in-
5 serting “appropriated—

6 “(i) for”;

7 (B) by striking the period and inserting “;
8 and”; and

9 (C) by adding at the end the following:

10 “(ii) for fiscal year 2002, such sums
11 as are necessary for grants under this
12 paragraph.”; and

13 (D) in subparagraph (G), by striking
14 “2001” and inserting “2002”.
