- 4 United States Code, is amended—
- 5 (1) by striking "(a) Except as provided in sub-
- 6 section (b), persons" and inserting "Persons"; and
- 7 (2) by striking subsection (b).
- 8 (b) Adjustment of Existing Annuities.—In the
- 9 case of an individual who was employed by the Veterans
- 10 Health Administration of the Department of Veterans Af-
- 11 fairs (or a predecessor entity) and who retired under chap-
- 12 ter 83 or chapter 84 of title 5, United States Code, during
- 13 the period beginning on September 20, 1986, and ending
- 14 on the date of the enactment of this Act, the annuity of
- 15 such individual shall be adjusted (effective as of the first
- 16 day of the first month beginning after the date of the en-
- 17 actment of this Act) so as to be the amount that such
- 18 annuity would have been if the provisions of section
- 19 4109(b) of title 38, United States Code, had not been re-
- 20 vived by section 7003 of the Omnibus Reconciliation Act
- 21 of 1986 (Public Law 99–509; 100 Stat. 1949) (and subse-
- 22 quently recodified as section 7426(b) of such title).
