A BILL

To amend the Fair Labor Standards Act of 1938 to increase the minimum wage by \$1 over 2 years.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Minimum Wage Act
5 of 2001”.

6 **SEC. 2. MINIMUM WAGE INCREASE.**

7 Paragraph (1) of section 6(a) of the Fair Labor
8 Standards Act of 1938 (29 U.S.C. 206(a)) is amended to
9 read as follows:

1 “(1) except as otherwise provided in this sec-
2 tion. Not less than \$5.15 an hour during the period
3 ending June 30, 2001, not less than \$5.65 an hour
4 during the year beginning July 1, 2001, and not less
5 than \$6.15 an hour beginning July 1, 2002;”.
