A BILL

To amend title 10, United States Code, to give certain rights to Department of Defense employees with respect to actions or determinations under Office of Management and Budget Circular A-76.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. RIGHTS OF DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE EM-**
4 **PLOYEES WITH RESPECT TO ACTIONS OR DE-**
5 **TERMINATIONS UNDER OMB CIRCULAR A-76.**

6 Section 2467 of title 10, United States Code, is
7 amended—

1 (1) in the heading, by inserting “; **appeal**
2 **rights**” after “**employees**”; and

3 (2) in subsection (b)—

4 (A) in the heading, by inserting “; APPEAL
5 RIGHTS” after “EMPLOYEES”; and

6 (B) by adding at the end of paragraph
7 (2)(A) the following: “Such an organization
8 shall be considered to be an interested party
9 under subchapter V of chapter 35 of title 31
10 and section 1491(b) of title 28 for purposes of
11 any action or determination under Office of
12 Management and Budget Circular A–76, and
13 shall have all the rights provided to such an in-
14 terested party in connection with such an action
15 or determination.”.
