A BILL

To repeal the sunset of the provisions of the Economic Growth and Tax Relief Reconciliation Act of 2001.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

SECTION 1. REPEAL OF SUNSET OF ECONOMIC GROWTH

AND TAX RELIEF RECONCILIATION ACT OF

2001.

(a) IN GENERAL.—Title IX of the Economic Growth

and Tax Relief Reconciliation Act of 2001 (Public Law

107–16) is hereby repealed.
