A BILL

To extend the deadline for commencement of construction of a hydroelectric project in Pennsylvania.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF TIME FOR FEDERAL ENERGY 4 REGULATORY COMMISSION PROJECT.

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding the time period 6 specified in section 13 of the Federal Power Act (16 7 U.S.C. 806) that would otherwise apply to the Federal En-8 ergy Regulatory Commission project numbered 4474, the 9 Allegheny River Lock and Dam #3 Project, the Commis-10 sion may, at the request of the licensee for the project and after reasonable notice, in accordance with the good
 faith, due diligence, and public interest requirements of
 that section and the Commission's procedures under that
 section, extend the time period during which the licensee
 is required to commence the construction of the project
 for 3 consecutive 2-year periods.

7 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—Subsection (a) shall take ef8 fect on the date of the expiration of the extension issued
9 by the Commission prior to the date of the enactment of
10 this Act under section 13 of the Federal Power Act (16
11 U.S.C. 806).

12 (c) REINSTATEMENT OF EXPIRED LICENSE.—If the 13 period required for commencement of construction of the 14 project described in subsection (a) has expired prior to the 15 date of the enactment of this Act, the Commission shall 16 reinstate the license effective as of the date of its expira-17 tion and the first extension authorized under subsection 18 (a) shall take effect on the date of such expiration.
