1 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION OF NATIONAL HANSEN'S DIS-**
2 **EASE PROGRAMS CENTER.**

3 (a) REFERENCES IN PUBLIC HEALTH SERVICE
4 ACT.—Section 320(a)(1) of the Public Health Service Act
5 (42 U.S.C. 247e(a)(1)) is amended by striking “Gillis W.
6 Long Hansen’s Disease Center” and inserting “National
7 Hansen’s Disease Programs Center”.

8 (b) PUBLIC LAW 105–78.—References in section 211
9 of Public Law 105–78, and in deeds, agreements, or other
10 documents under such section, to the Gillis W. Long Han-
11 sen’s Disease Center shall be deemed to be references to
12 the National Hansen’s Disease Programs Center.

13 (c) OTHER REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law,
14 map, regulation, document, paper, or other record of the
15 United States to the Gillis W. Long Hansen’s Disease
16 Center shall be deemed to be a reference to the National
17 Hansen’s Disease Programs Center.
