1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Death Tax Repeal Act5 of 2001".

6 SEC. 2. REPEAL OF ESTATE AND GIFT TAXES.

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subtitle B of the Internal Rev8 enue Code of 1986 (relating to estate, gift, and genera9 tion-skipping taxes) is hereby repealed.

10 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The repeal made by sub-11 section (a) shall apply to estates of decedents dying, gifts

- 1 made, and generation-skipping transfers made after the
- $2 \quad {\rm date \ of \ the \ enactment \ of \ this \ Act.}$
