3 **SECTION 1. ADDITIONS TO APPALACHIAN REGION.**

4 Section 403 of the Appalachian Regional Develop-
5 ment Act of 1965 (40 U.S.C. App.) is amended in the
6 undesignated paragraph relating to Tennessee—

7 (1) by inserting “Hickman,” after “Hawkins,”;

- 1 (2) by inserting “Lawrence, Lewis,” after
- 2 “Knox,”;
- 3 (3) by inserting “Perry,” after “Overton,”; and
- 4 (4) by inserting “Wayne,” after “Washington,”.
