## A BILL

To authorize the President to posthumously advance the late Admiral Raymond Ames Spruance to the grade of Fleet Admiral of the United States Navy.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. POSTHUMOUS ADVANCEMENT OF ADMIRAL**  
4 **RAYMOND AMES SPRUANCE TO FLEET ADMI-**  
5 **RAL OF THE UNITED STATES NAVY.**

6 (a) **ADVANCEMENT.**—The President is authorized  
7 and requested to posthumously advance the late Admiral

1 Raymond Ames Spruance, United States Navy, retired, to  
2 the grade of Fleet Admiral of the United States Navy on  
3 the retired list of the Navy.

4 (b) ADDITIONAL BENEFITS NOT TO ACCRUE.—No  
5 increase in compensation or benefits based on the service  
6 of Raymond Ames Spruance in the Navy shall result from  
7 the posthumous advancement authorized and requested  
8 under subsection (a).
