A BILL

To extend the expiration date of the Defense Production
Act of 1950, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Defense Production
5 Act Amendments of 2001”.

1 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF THE DEFENSE PRODUCTION ACT OF**
2 **1950.**

3 Section 717(a) of the Defense Production Act of
4 1950 (50 U.S.C. App. 2166(a)) is amended by striking
5 “September 30, 2001” and inserting “September 30,
6 2004”.

7 **SEC. 3. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

8 Section 711(b) of the Defense Production Act of
9 1950 (50 U.S.C. App. 2161(b)) is amended by striking
10 “1996 through 2001” and inserting “2002 through
11 2004”.

12 **SEC. 4. TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS.**

13 The Defense Production Act of 1950 is amended as
14 follows:

15 (1) In section 301(a)(1) (50 U.S.C. App.
16 2091(a)(1)), by striking “714(a)(1) of this Act” and
17 inserting “702(16)”.

18 (2) In subparagraphs (A), (B), and (C) of sec-
19 tion 301(e)(1) (50 U.S.C. App. 2091(e)(1)), by
20 striking “industrial resource shortfall” each place
21 such term appears and inserting “industrial resource
22 or critical technology item shortfall”.

23 (3) In sections 301(e)(1)(D)(ii) and
24 303(a)(7)(B) (50 U.S.C. App. 2091(e)(1)(D)(ii),
25 2093(a)(7)(B)), by inserting “item” after “critical
26 technology”.

1 (4) In section 304(b)(1), (50 U.S.C. App.
2 2094(b)(1)), by striking “711(e)” and inserting
3 “711(b)”.

4 (5) In sections 301(e)(2)(B) and 309(a)(1), (50
5 U.S.C. App. 2091(e)(2)(B), 2099(a)(1)), by striking
6 “Committee on Banking, Finance and Urban Affairs
7 of the House of Representatives” and inserting
8 “Committee on Financial Services of the House of
9 Representatives”.
