3 **SECTION 1. PROHIBITION ON ISSUANCE OF CERTAIN**
4 **VISAS.**

5 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, an immi-
6 grant or nonimmigrant visa shall not be issued to any cit-

1 izen of the People’s Republic of China who the Secretary
2 of State determines—

3 (1) participates in or otherwise supports the
4 harvesting, transplantation, or trafficking of organs
5 of executed Chinese prisoners; or

6 (2) seeks the visa for the purpose of training in
7 organ or bodily tissue transplantation.
