## SECTION 1. REPEAL OF LOW-INCOME HOUSING CREDIT DISQUALIFICATION FOR BUILDINGS RECEIV ING MODERATE REHABILITATION ASSIST ANCE.

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Paragraph (2) of section 42(c) of
6 the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (defining qualified low7 income building) is amended by striking the last sentence.
8 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
9 this section shall apply to moderate rehabilitation assist10 ance provided after the date of the enactment of this Act.

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
