AN ACT

To authorize the Secretary of the Interior to conduct a study of the feasibility of providing adequate upstream and downstream passage for fish at the Chiloquin Dam on the Sprague River, Oregon.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Chiloquin Dam Fish
3 Passage Feasibility Study Act of 2001”.

4 **SEC. 2. CHILOQUIN DAM FISH PASSAGE FEASIBILITY**
5 **STUDY.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of the Interior
7 shall, in collaboration with all interested parties, including
8 the Modoc Point Irrigation District, the Klamath Tribes,
9 and the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife, conduct
10 a study of the feasibility of providing adequate upstream
11 and downstream passage for fish at the Chiloquin Dam
12 on the Sprague River, Oregon.

13 (b) SUBJECTS.—The study shall include—

14 (1) review of all alternatives for providing such
15 passage, including the removal of the dam;

16 (2) determination of the most appropriate alter-
17 native;

18 (3) development of recommendations for imple-
19 menting such alternative; and

20 (4) examination of mitigation needed for up-
21 stream and downstream water users, and for Klam-
22 ath tribal non-consumptive uses, as a result of such
23 implementation.

24 (c) REPORT.—The Secretary shall submit to the Con-
25 gress a report on the findings, conclusions, and rec-

- 1 ommendations of the study by not later than 1 year after
- 2 the date of the enactment of this Act.
