## A BILL

To amend title II of the Social Security Act to repeal the Government pension offset and windfall elimination provisions.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Social Security Fair-
- 5 ness Act of 2001".

#### 6 SEC. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.

- 7 The amendments made by this Act shall apply with
- 8 respect to monthly insurance benefits payable under title
- 9 II of the Social Security Act for months after December
- 10 2001. Notwithstanding section 215(f) of the Social Secu-
- 11 rity Act, the Commissioner of Social Security shall adjust
- 12 primary insurance amounts to the extent necessary to take
- 13 into account the amendments made by section 2.
