A BILL

To direct the Secretary of the Interior to provide assistance for the maintenance of gravesites of former Presidents of the United States.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ASSISTANCE FOR MAINTENANCE OF PRESI-**
4 **DENTIAL GRAVESITES.**

5 (a) SHORT TITLE.—This Act may be cited as the
6 “American Legacy Preservation Act”.

7 (b) ASSISTANCE FOR MAINTENANCE OF
8 GRAVESITES.—Upon the request of an owner of non-Fed-
9 eral land or the head of any Federal agency with jurisdic-

1 tion over Federal land where a gravesite of a former Presi-
2 dent of the United States is located, the Secretary of the
3 Interior shall, with funds otherwise available to the Sec-
4 retary for such general purposes, provide technical assist-
5 ance, financial assistance, or both, to such owner or Fed-
6 eral agency for the maintenance of that gravesite.
