## A BILL

To authorize the Pyramid of Remembrance Foundation to establish a memorial in the District of Columbia or its environs to soldiers who have lost their lives during peacekeeping operations, humanitarian efforts, training, terrorist attacks, or covert operations.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. AUTHORITY TO ESTABLISH MEMORIAL.**

4 (a) *IN GENERAL.*—*The Pyramid of Remembrance*  
5 *Foundation is authorized to establish a memorial on Fed-*  
6 *eral land within the area designated as “Area II” on the*  
7 *map referred to in section 2(e) of the Commemorative Works*  
8 *Act (40 U.S.C. 1002(e)), to honor members of the Armed*  
9 *Forces of the United States who have lost their lives during*  
10 *peacekeeping operations, humanitarian efforts, training,*  
11 *terrorist attacks, or covert operations.*

12 (b) *COMPLIANCE WITH STANDARDS FOR COMMEMORA-*  
13 *TIVE WORKS.*—*The Pyramid of Remembrance Foundation*  
14 *shall establish the memorial authorized by this Act in ac-*  
15 *cordance with the Commemorative Works Act (40 U.S.C.*  
16 *1001, et seq.), except that subsection (b) and (c) of section*  
17 *3 of that Act shall not apply.*

18 **SEC. 2. FUNDS FOR MEMORIAL.**

19 (a) *USE OF FEDERAL FUNDS PROHIBITED.*—*Except*  
20 *as provided by the Commemorative Works Act, no Federal*  
21 *funds may be used to pay any expense of the establishment*  
22 *of the memorial.*

23 (b) *DEPOSIT OF EXCESS FUNDS.*—*If—*

24 (1) *upon payment of all expenses of the establish-*  
25 *ment of the memorial, including payment to the*

1       *Treasury of the maintenance and preservation*  
2       *amount required by section 8(b) of the Commemora-*  
3       *tive Works Act; or*  
4             (2) *upon expiration of the authority for the me-*  
5       *morial under section 10(b) of the Commemorative*  
6       *Works Act,*  
7       *there remains a balance of funds received for the establish-*  
8       *ment of the memorial, the Pyramid of Remembrance Foun-*  
9       *dation shall transmit that balance to the Secretary of the*  
10       *Treasury for deposit in the account provided for in section*  
11       *8(b)(1) of the Commemorative Works Act.*
