A BILL

To prohibit the importation for sale of foreign-made flags of the United States of America.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Genuine American
- 5 Flag Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. IMPORTATION FOR SALE OF FOREIGN-MADE AMER-
- 7 ICAN FLAGS PROHIBITED.
- 8 Beginning 6 months after the date of the enactment
- 9 of this Act, no flag of the United States of America (re-
- 10 gardless of size and whether or not in compliance with

- 1 the standard proportions prescribed by Executive order)
- 2 that is the product or manufacture of any foreign country
- 3 or instrumentality may be imported for sale into the

4 United States.
