Mr. KNOLLENBERG introduced the following bill; which was referred to the

A BILL

To increase compliance with the registration requirement under the Military Selective Service Act by providing a temporary amnesty period during which persons who were required to present themselves for registration under such Act, but failed to do so in accordance with the time periods specified in Presidential Proclamation Number 4771, may present themselves for registration without fear of penalty.

1 **SECTION 1. SPECIAL TEMPORARY REGISTRATION PERIOD**
2 **UNDER MILITARY SELECTIVE SERVICE ACT.**

3 (a) **ADDITIONAL REGISTRATION OPPORTUNITY.**—
4 During the 60-day period beginning on the date of the
5 enactment of this Act, any person between the ages of 18
6 and 26 who, before that date, was required to present him-
7 self for registration under section 3 of the Military Selec-
8 tive Service Act (50 U.S.C. App. 453), but failed to do
9 so in accordance with the time periods specified in Presi-
10 dential Proclamation Number 4771 (94 Stat. 3775; 50
11 U.S.C. App. 453 note), may present himself for registra-
12 tion under such section in accordance with the registration
13 procedures prescribed by the Director of Selective Service.
14 (b) **AMNESTY.**—The penalties specified in section 12
15 of the Military Selective Service Act (50 U.S.C. App. 462)
16 or any other provision of law for failure to timely submit
17 to registration under section 3 of such Act (50 U.S.C.
18 App. 453) shall not apply to any person described in sub-
19 section (a) who utilizes the special registration period pro-
20 vided by such subsection to comply with the registration
21 requirement of such section 3.
