- 3 SECTION 1. ESTABLISHMENT OF AT LEAST ONE WEAPONS
- 4 OF MASS DESTRUCTION CIVIL SUPPORT
- 5 TEAM IN EACH STATE.
- 6 (a) Requirement.—The Secretary of Defense shall
- 7 establish at least one Weapons of Mass Destruction Civil

- 1 Support Team in each State, plus an additional team
- 2 under the direction of the National Guard Bureau.
- 3 (b) Definitions.—For purposes of this section:
- 4 (1) The term "Weapons of Mass Destruction 5 Civil Support Team" means a team of members of
- 6 the reserve components of the armed forces that is
- 7 established under section 12310(c) of title 10,
- 8 United States Code, in support of emergency pre-
- 9 paredness programs to prepare for or to respond to
- any emergency involving the use of a weapon of
- 11 mass destruction.
- 12 (2) The term "State" includes the District of
- 13 Columbia, Puerto Rico, the Virgin Islands, and
- 14 Guam.
- 15 (c) Deadline for Implementation.—The Sec-
- 16 retary of Defense shall ensure that subsection (a) is fully
- 17 implemented not later than September 30, 2003.
