## A BILL

To require Secretary of Defense to expand the range maintenance program of the Department of Defense regarding the removal of unexploded ordnance and munitions constituents from live impact areas of military training ranges to include any underwater portions of the live impact areas.

1	SEC. 2. REMOVAL OF UNEXPLODED ORDNANCE AND MUNI-
2	TIONS CONSTITUENTS FROM UNDERWATER
3	PORTIONS OF LIVE IMPACT AREAS.
4	(a) Expansion of Existing Range Maintenance
5	Program.—The Secretary of Defense shall ensure that
6	the range maintenance program carried out by the De-
7	partment of Defense to remove unexploded ordnance and
8	munitions constituents from live impact areas of military
9	training ranges and to perform environmental remediation
10	in connection with the removal of such unexploded ord-
11	nance and munitions constituents includes any underwater
12	portions of the live impact areas.
13	(b) Budget Reports.—The budget justification
14	materials submitted to the Congress in support of the
15	budget of the Department of Defense for fiscal year 2003,
16	and subsequent fiscal years, shall set forth separately the
17	amounts requested to carry out the removal of unexploded
18	ordnance and munitions constituents from the underwater
19	portions of live impact areas of military training ranges
20	and related environmental remediation

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
