A BILL

To amend title XVIII of the Social Security Act to provide for coverage of cholesterol and blood lipid screening under the Medicare Program.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Medicare Cholesterol
- 5 Screening Coverage Act of 2001".

1	SEC. 2. MEDICARE COVERAGE OF CHOLESTEROL AND
2	BLOOD LIPID SCREENING.
3	(a) In General.—Section 1861 of the Social Secu-
4	rity Act (42 U.S.C. 1395x) is amended—
5	(1) in subsection $(s)(2)$ —
6	(A) by striking "and" at the end of sub-
7	paragraph (U);
8	(B) by adding "and" at the end of sub-
9	paragraph (V); and
10	(C) by adding at the end the following new
11	subparagraph:
12	"(W) cholesterol and other blood lipid screening
13	tests (as defined in subsection $(ww)(1)$);"; and
14	(2) by adding at the end the following new sub-
15	section:
16	"Cholesterol and Other Blood Lipid Screening Test
17	``(ww)(1) The term 'cholesterol and other blood lipid
18	screening test' means diagnostic testing of cholesterol and
19	other lipid levels of the blood for the purpose of early de-
20	tection of abnormal cholesterol and other lipid levels.
21	"(2) The Secretary shall establish standards, in con-
22	sultation with appropriate organizations, regarding the
23	frequency and type of cholesterol and other blood lipid
24	screening tests for individuals who do not otherwise qual-
25	ify for coverage for cholesterol and other blood lipid test-
26	ing based on established clinical diagnoses.".

1	(b) Frequency.—Section 1862(a)(1) of such Act
2	(42 U.S.C. 1395y(a)(1)) is amended
3	(1) by striking "and" at the end of subpara-
4	graph (H);
5	(2) by striking the semicolon at the end of sub-
6	paragraph (I) and inserting "; and; and
7	(3) by adding at the end the following new sub-
8	paragraph:
9	"(J) in the case of a cholesterol and other blood
10	lipid screening test (as defined in section
11	1861(ww)(1)), which is performed more frequently
12	than is covered under section 1861(ww)(2).".
13	(c) Effective Date.—The amendments made by
14	this section shall apply to tests furnished on or after Janu-
15	ary 1 2002

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
