A BILL

To amend title 46, United States Code, to exempt from inspection certain small passenger vessels that operate in waters of the United States only in the Virgin Islands.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. EXEMPTION FROM INSPECTION FOR CERTAIN
- 4 SMALL PASSENGER VESSELS THAT OPERATE
- 5 ONLY IN THE VIRGIN ISLANDS.
- 6 Section 3302 of title 46, United States Code, is
- 7 amended by adding at the end the following:
- 8 "(n) A small passenger vessel that operates in waters
- 9 of the United States only in the Virgin Islands shall not

- 1 be subject to inspection under section 3301(8) of this title
- 2 if it carries no more than 12 passengers.".
