3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Vicksburg National
- 5 Military Park Boundary Modification Act".

1 SEC. 2. ACQUISITION OF PROPERTY.

2 The Secretary of the Interior may acquire, with the
3 consent of the owners, by donation, purchase with donated
4 or appropriated funds, or exchange, the following:

5 (1) PEMBERTON'S HEADQUARTERS.—The prop6 erty known as Pemberton's Headquarters, as gen7 erally depicted on the map entitled "Boundary Map,
8 Pemberton's Headquarters at Vicksburg National
9 Military Park", numbered 306/80015A, and dated
10 August 2001.

(2) PARKING AND OTHER FACILITIES.—Not
more than 1 acre of land or interest in land abutting
or near the property described in paragraph 1 for
the purpose of providing parking and other facilities
related to operating Pemberton's Headquarters as a
visitor site.

17 SEC. 3. MODIFICATION OF BOUNDARY; ADMINISTRATION.

18 Upon the acquisition of property under section 2—
19 (1) the boundary of Vicksburg National Mili20 tary Park shall be modified to include the acquired
21 property; and

(2) the Secretary of the Interior shall administer the acquired property as part of Vicksburg National Military Park in accordance with applicable
laws and regulations.

1 SEC. 4. MAP ON FILE.

2 The map referred to in section 2(1) shall be on file3 in the appropriate offices of the National Park Service of4 the Department of the Interior.
