A BILL

- To provide that the Davis-Bacon Act shall not apply to contracts for the construction and repair of schools and libraries, and for other purposes.
 - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
 - 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
 - 4 This Act may be cited as the "School and Library
 - 5 Construction Affordability Act".
 - 6 SEC. 2. PURPOSE.
 - 7 The purpose of the amendments made by this Act
- 8 is—

- 1 (1) to amend the Act of March 3, 1931 (Chap-
- 2 ter 411; 46 Stat. 1494; 40 U.S.C. 276a et seq.;
- 3 commonly known as the Davis-Bacon Act) to make
- 4 it inapplicable to contracts for school or library con-
- 5 struction and repair and thereby reduce school con-
- 6 struction and repair costs by 5 to 38 percent and
- 7 thereby saving funds that can be used to improve
- 8 education, repair and construct modern schools and
- 9 libraries, and provide tax relief; and
- 10 (2) to harmonize Federal laws with a majority
- of the States.
- 12 SEC. 3. DAVIS-BACON ACT.
- The first section of the Act of March 3, 1931 (Chap-
- 14 ter 411; 46 Stat. 1494; 40 U.S.C. 276a; commonly known
- 15 as the Davis-Bacon Act) is amended by adding at the end
- 16 the following:
- 17 "(c) Subsection (a) does not apply to any contract
- 18 which is entered into to construct or repair facilities of
- 19 an educational agency or library.".
- 20 SEC. 4. COPELAND ACT.
- 21 Section 2 of the Act of June 13, 1934 (Chapter 482;
- 22 48 Stat. 948; 40 U.S.C. 276c; commonly known as the
- 23 Copeland Act) is amended by adding at the end the fol-
- 24 lowing: "This section does not apply to any contractor or

- 1 subcontractor which is engaged in the construction or re-
- 2 pair of facilities of an educational agency or library.".

3 SEC. 5. CONSTRUCTION.

- 4 Nothing in this Act or the amendments made by this
- 5 Act may be construed to diminish in any way the quality
- 6 of facility construction or repair or to affect Federal,
- 7 State, and local guidelines, codes, and regulations relating
- 8 to construction or repair quality.

9 SEC. 6. EFFECTIVE DATE.

- The amendments made by this Act shall take effect
- 11 30 days after the date of enactment of this Act but shall
- 12 not affect any contract in existence on such date of enact-
- 13 ment or made pursuant to invitation for bids outstanding
- 14 on such date of enactment.
