- 7 (a) WIFE'S INSURANCE BENEFITS.—Section
 8 202(b)(5)(A) of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C.

402(b)(5)(A)) is amended by striking "divorced wife—"
and all that follows through "shall be entitled" and inserting "divorced wife meets the requirements of subparagraphs (A) through (D) of paragraph (1), shall be entitled".

6 (b) HUSBAND'S INSURANCE BENEFITS.—Section 7 202(c)(5)(A) of such Act (42 U.S.C. 402(c)(5)(A)) is 8 amended by striking "divorced husband—" and all that 9 follows through "shall be entitled" and inserting "divorced 10 husband meets the requirements of subparagraphs (A) 11 through (D) of paragraph (1), shall be entitled".

(c) EXEMPTION FROM DEDUCTIONS ON ACCOUNT OF
WORK.—Section 203(b)(2) of such Act (42 U.S.C.
403(b)(2)) is amended—

(1) by striking "(2)(A) Except as" and all that
follows through "the benefit to which" and inserting
the following: "(2) In any case in which any of the
other persons referred to in paragraph (1)(B) is entitled to monthly benefits as a divorced spouse under
subsection (b) or (c) of section 202 for any month,
the benefit to which"; and

1 SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.

2 The amendments made by section 1 shall apply with3 respect to benefits for months after the date of the enact-4 ment of this Act.
