1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE. 3 4 This Act may be cited as the "Medicare Physician 5 Payment Fairness Act of 2001". SEC. 2. SPECIFICATION OF THE UPDATE FOR PAYMENTS 6 7 UNDER THE MEDICARE PHYSICIAN FEE 8 SCHEDULE FOR 2002. 9 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1848(d) of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1395w–4(d)) is amended by adding 10 11 at the end the following new paragraph: 12 "(5) Conversion factor for 2002.— 13 "(A) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding the 14 update otherwise determined under paragraph 15 (4) for 2002, the conversion factor established under this subsection for 2002 shall be 0.9 per-16 17 cent less than the conversion factor established 18 under this subsection for 2001. 19 "(B) NO EFFECT FOR SUBSEQUENT PERI-20 ODS.—The conversion factor under paragraph 21 (1) and the update adjustment factor under 22 paragraph (4)(B) for a year after 2002 shall be 23 applied and computed as if subparagraph (A)

had not been in effect.

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"(C) CONFORMING PROVISIONS TO EN-1 2 SURE NO EFFECT FOR SUBSEQUENT PERI-3 ODS.—In carrying out subparagraph (B): 4 "(i) NO EFFECT ON TARGET FOR AL-LOWED EXPENDITURES.—The allowed ex-5 6 penditures under paragraph (4)(C)(iii) for 7 years after 2002 shall be applied and com-8 puted as if subparagraph (A) had not been 9 in effect. "(ii) Removal of additional ex-10 11 PENDITURES FROM ACTUAL EXPENDI-12 TURES.—In applying paragraph (4)(B) for 13 years beginning with 2003, the actual ex-14 penditures for 2002 shall be the actual ex-15 penditures otherwise determined multiplied 16 by the ratio of (I) the amount of the con-17 version factor that would have applied for 18 2002 under this subsection but for this 19 paragraph, to (II) the amount of the con-

SEC. 3. STUDY AND REPORT BY MEDPAC ON REPLACING OR MODIFYING THE SUSTAINABLE GROWTH RATE AS A FACTOR IN DETERMINING THE UP DATE FOR PAYMENTS UNDER THE MEDICARE PHYSICIAN FEE SCHEDULE.

6 (a) STUDY.—The Medicare Payment Advisory Com-7 mission shall conduct a study on replacing or modifying 8 the sustainable growth rate (as determined under sub-9 section (f) of section 1848 of the Social Security Act (42) 10 U.S.C. 1395w–4)) as a factor in determining the update for payments under the Medicare physician fee schedule 11 under such section such that the factor used more fully 12 accounts for changes in the unit costs of providing physi-13 cians' services. 14

(b) REPORT TO CONGRESS.—Not later than March
1, 2002, the Commission shall submit to Congress a report
on the study conducted under subsection (a) together with
such recommendations for legislation and administrative
action as the Commission determines appropriate.

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
