AN ACT

- To amend title 38, United States Code, to enact into law eligibility of certain Reservists and their dependents for burial in Arlington National Cemetery, and for other purposes.
 - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

SECTION 1. ELIGIBILITY OF CERTAIN PERSONS FOR BUR IAL IN ARLINGTON NATIONAL CEMETERY. (a) IN GENERAL.—(1) Chapter 24 of title 38, United

4 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol-5 lowing new section:

6 "\$1A2412. Arlington National Cemetery: eligibility of 7 certain persons for burial

8 ((a)(1)) The remains of a member or former member 9 of a reserve component of the Armed Forces who at the 10 time of death was under 60 years of age and who, but 11 for age, would have been eligible at the time of death for retired pay under chapter 1223 of title 10 may be buried 12 13 in Arlington National Cemetery on the same basis as the remains of members of the Armed Forces entitled to re-14 tired pay under that chapter. 15

16 "(2) The remains of the dependents of a member 17 whose remains are permitted under paragraph (1) to be 18 buried in Arlington National Cemetery may be buried in 19 that cemetery on the same basis as dependents of mem-20 bers of the Armed Forces entitled to retired pay under 21 such chapter 1223.

"(b)(1) The remains of a member of a reserve component of the Armed Forces who dies in the line of duty
while on active duty for training or inactive duty training
may be buried in Arlington National Cemetery on the

same basis as the remains of a member of the Armed
 Forces who dies while on active duty.

3 "(2) The remains of the dependents of a member 4 whose remains are permitted under paragraph (1) to be 5 buried in Arlington National Cemetery may be buried in 6 that cemetery on the same basis as dependents of mem-7 bers on active duty.".

8 (2) The table of sections at the beginning of chapter
9 24 of title 38, United States Code, is amended by adding
10 at the end the following new item:

"2412. Arlington National Cemetery: eligibility of certain persons for burial.".

(b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—Section 2412 of title 38,
United States Code, as added by subsection (a), shall
apply with respect to interments occurring on or after the
date of the enactment of this Act.

15SEC. 2. PLACEMENT OF MEMORIAL IN ARLINGTON NA-16TIONAL CEMETERY HONORING THE VICTIMS17OF THE ACTS OF TERRORISM PERPETRATED18AGAINST THE UNITED STATES ON SEP-19TEMBER 11, 2001.

(a) AUTHORIZATION TO PLACE MEMORIAL.—The
Secretary of the Army is authorized to construct and place
in Arlington National Cemetery a memorial marker honoring the victims of the acts of terrorism perpetrated
against the United States on September 11, 2001.

(b) CONSULTATION WITH FAMILIES OF VICTIMS BE FORE USE OF AUTHORITY.—The Secretary of the Army
 shall consult with the families of victims of such acts of
 terrorism prior to the exercise of the authority provided
 for under subsection (a).
