A BILL

To amend title 38, United States Code, to enact into law eligibility of certain veterans and their dependents for burial in Arlington National Cemetery. Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
 SECTION 1. ELIGIBILITY OF CERTAIN PERSONS FOR BUR IAL IN ARLINGTON NATIONAL CEMETERY.
 (a) IN GENERAL.—(1) Chapter 24 of title 38, United
 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol lowing new section:

8 "§2412. Arlington National Cemetery: eligibility of 9 certain persons for burial

10 (a)(1) The remains of a member or former member of a reserve component of the Armed Forces who at the 11 12 time of death was under 60 years of age and who, but 13 for age, would have been eligible at the time of death for retired pay under chapter 1223 of title 10 may be buried 14 15 in Arlington National Cemetery on the same basis as the remains of members of the Armed Forces entitled to re-16 17 tired pay under that chapter.

18 "(2) The remains of the dependents of a member 19 whose remains are permitted under paragraph (1) to be 20 buried in Arlington National Cemetery may be buried in 21 that cemetery on the same basis as dependents of mem-22 bers of the Armed Forces entitled to retired pay under 23 such chapter 1223.

24 "(b)(1) The remains of a member of a reserve compo-25 nent of the Armed Forces who dies in the line of duty

while on active duty for training or inactive duty training
 may be buried in Arlington National Cemetery on the
 same basis as the remains of a member of the Armed
 Forces who dies while on active duty.

5 "(2) The remains of the dependents of a member 6 whose remains are permitted under paragraph (1) to be 7 buried in Arlington National Cemetery may be buried in 8 that cemetery on the same basis as dependents of mem-9 bers on active duty.".

10 (2) The table of sections at the beginning of chapter
11 24 of title 38, United States Code, is amended by adding
12 at the end the following new item:

"2412. Arlington National Cemetery: eligibility of certain persons for burial.".

(b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—Section 2412 of title 38,
14 United States Code, as added by subsection (a), shall
15 apply with respect to interments occurring on or after the
16 date of the enactment of this Act.

17 SEC. 2. PLACEMENT OF MEMORIAL IN ARLINGTON NA-

18TIONAL CEMETERY HONORING THE VICTIMS19OF THE ACTS OF TERRORISM PERPETRATED20AGAINST THE UNITED STATES ON SEP-21TEMBER 11, 2001.

(a) AUTHORIZATION TO PLACE MEMORIAL.—The Secretary of the Army is authorized to construct and place in
Arlington National Cemetery a memorial marker honoring

the victims of the acts of terrorism perpetrated against the
 United States on September 11, 2001.

3 (b) CONSULTATION WITH FAMILIES OF VICTIMS BE4 FORE USE OF AUTHORITY.—The Secretary of the Army
5 shall consult with the families of victims of such acts of
6 terrorism prior to the exercise of the authority provided for
7 under subsection (a).

Amend the title so as to read: "A bill to amend title 38, United States Code, to enact into law eligibility of certain Reservists and their dependents for burial in Arlington National Cemetery, and for other purposes.".
