5 Guard on duty described in the following sen6 tence"; and

7 (2) in the second sentence, by inserting before the period the following: ", and, in the case of a 8 9 member of the National Guard, shall include training or other duty authorized by section 502(f) of 10 11 title 32, United States Code, at the request of the 12 President, for or in support of an operation during 13 a war or national emergency declared by the Presi-14 dent or Congress".
