A BILL

To revise the boundaries of the George Washington Birthplace National Monument, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. ADDITION TO NATIONAL MONUMENT.
- 4 The boundaries of the George Washington Birthplace
- 5 National Monument (hereinafter referred to as the "Na-
- 6 tional Monument") are hereby modified to include the
- 7 area comprising approximately 115 acres, as generally de-
- 8 picted on the map entitled "George Washington Birth-
- 9 place National Monument Boundary Map", numbered
- 10 332/80,023 and dated October 2001, which shall be on

- 1 file and available for public inspection in the appropriate
- 2 offices of the National Park Service, Department of the
- 3 Interior.

4 SEC. 2. ACQUISITION OF LANDS.

- 5 Within the boundaries of the National Monument, the
- 6 Secretary of the Interior (hereinafter referred to as the
- 7 "Secretary") is authorized to acquire lands, or interests
- 8 therein, from willing owners by donation, purchase with
- 9 donated money or appropriated funds, or exchange.

10 SEC. 3. ADMINISTRATION OF NATIONAL MONUMENT.

- In administering the National Monument, the Sec-
- 12 retary shall take actions necessary to preserve and inter-
- 13 pret the history and resources associated with George
- 14 Washington, the generations of the Washington family
- 15 who lived in the vicinity and their contemporaries, and
- 16 18th century plantation life and society.
