Mr. SMITH of Washington introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce

A BILL

To amend the Wool Products Labeling Act of 1939 and the Textile Fiber Products Identification Act to require that labeling required under those Acts identify products processed or manufactured in a territory of the United States.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “United States Terri-
5 tories Truth in Labelling Act of 2001”.

1 **SEC. 2. REQUIREMENT THAT LABELS IDENTIFY WOOL**
2 **AND TEXTILE FIBER PRODUCTS PROCESSED**
3 **OR MANUFACTURED IN TERRITORIES OF THE**
4 **UNITED STATES.**

5 (a) **WOOL PRODUCTS.**—Section 4(a)(2) of the Wool
6 Products Labeling Act of 1939 (15 U.S.C. 68b(A)(2)) is
7 amended by adding after subparagraph (D) the following:

8 “(E) the full name of the Territory where
9 processed or manufactured.”.

10 (b) **TEXTILE FIBER PRODUCTS.**—Section 4(b) of the
11 Textile Fiber Products Identification Act (15 U.S.C.
12 70b(b)) is amended by adding after paragraph (5) the fol-
13 lowing:

14 “(6) If it is a textile fiber product processed or
15 manufactured in a Territory, it be so identified with
16 the full name of such Territory.”.

17 (c) **APPLICATION.**—The amendments made by sub-
18 sections (a) and (b) shall apply after the expiration of the
19 120-day period that begins on the date of the enactment
20 of this Act.
