5 (a) WOOL PRODUCTS.—Section 4(a)(2) of the Wool
6 Products Labeling Act of 1939 (15 U.S.C. 68b(A)(2)) is
7 amended by adding after subparagraph (D) the following:
8 "(E) the full name of the Territory where
9 processed or manufactured.".

(b) TEXTILE FIBER PRODUCTS.—Section 4(b) of the
Textile Fiber Products Identification Act (15 U.S.C.
70b(b)) is amended by adding after paragraph (5) the following:

"(6) If it is a textile fiber product processed or
manufactured in a Territory, it be so identified with
the full name of such Territory.".

(c) APPLICATION.—The amendments made by subsections (a) and (b) shall apply after the expiration of the
120-day period that begins on the date of the enactment
of this Act.
