1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—

2 (1) IN GENERAL.—The amendment made by
3 subsection (a) applies to articles entered, or with4 drawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
5 the 15th day after the date of the enactment of this
6 Act.

7 (2) RELIQUIDATION.—Notwithstanding section
8 514 of the Tariff Act of 1930 (19 U.S.C. 1514), or
9 any other provision of law, upon a request filed with
10 the Customs Service on or before the 90th day after
11 the date of the enactment of this Act, any entry, or
12 withdrawal from warehouse for consumption, of an
13 article—

14 (A) that was made after December 31,
15 2000, and before the 15th day after the date of
16 the enactment of this Act, and

17 (B) with respect to which there would have
18 been no duty, if the amendment made by sub19 section (a) applied to such entry or withdrawal,

shall be liquidated or reliquidated as though such
 entry or withdrawal occurred on the 15th day after
 the date of the enactment of this Act.
