3 SECTION 1. REGULATIONS FOR HUNTING SEASONS FOR

4 DOUBLE-CRESTED CORMORANTS.

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of the Interior
6 shall, by not later than 6 months after the date of the
7 enactment of this Act, issue regulations under section 3

of the Migratory Bird Treaty Act (16 U.S.C. 704) that 1 2 authorize States to establish hunting seasons for double-3 crested cormorants.

4 (b) CONTENT.—Regulations issued under this section 5 shall—

(1) permit the taking by an individual of 10 6 7 double-crested cormorants during each day of a 8 hunting season established under the regulations;

9 (2) permit an individual to have in his or her 10 possession 20 double-crested cormorants legally 11 taken in a hunting season established under the reg-12 ulations;

13 (3) require that the dates of any hunting season 14 established under the regulations in a State cor-15 respond generally with other waterfowl hunting sea-16 sons in that State; and

17 (4) subject to the other requirements of this 18 subsection, authorize a hunting season established 19 under the regulations to begin at any time after the 20 date of the issuance of the regulations.
