## A BILL

To amend title 38, United States Code, to provide full service-connected disability benefits for persons disabled by treatment or vocational rehabilitation provided by the Department of Veterans Affairs and for survivors of persons dying from such treatment.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Injured Veterans Ben-
- 5 efits Eligibility Act of 2002".

1	SEC. 2. FULL SERVICE-CONNECTED DISABILITY BENEFITS
2	FOR PERSON DISABLED BY TREATMENT OR
3	VOCATIONAL REHABILITATION.

- 4 (a) In General.—Section 1151 of title 38, United
- 5 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol-
- 6 lowing new subsection:
- 7 "(c) A qualifying additional disability or a qualifying
- 8 death under this section shall be considered to be a serv-
- 9 ice-connected disability, or a death due to a service-con-
- 10 nected disability, for purposes of all laws administered by
- 11 the Secretary.".
- 12 (b) Effective Date.—Subsection (c) of section
- 13 1151 of title 38, United States Code, as added by sub-
- 14 section (a), shall apply with respect to service-connection
- 15 for purposes of eligibility for benefits and services provided
- 16 by the Secretary of Veterans Affairs on or after the date
- 17 of the enactment of this Act.
