2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REV. LEON SULLIVAN POST OFFICE BUILDING.**

4 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
5 Postal Service located at 6150 North Broad Street in

1 Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, shall be known and designated
2 as the “Rev. Leon Sullivan Post Office Building”.

3 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
4 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
5 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
6 be deemed to be a reference to the Rev. Leon Sullivan
7 Post Office Building.
