## **AN ACT**

To designate certain Federal lands in the State of Utah as the Gunn McKay Nature Preserve, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Gunn McKay Nature  
3 Preserve Act”.

4 **SEC. 2. DEFINITIONS.**

5 For the purposes of this Act:

6 (1) **PRESERVE.**—The term “Preserve” means  
7 the Gunn McKay Nature Preserve as so designated  
8 by section 3(a).

9 (2) **SECRETARY.**—The term “Secretary” means  
10 the Secretary of Agriculture.

11 **SEC. 3. NATURE PRESERVE.**

12 (a) **DESIGNATION.**—The approximately 15 acres of  
13 National Forest System land generally depicted on the  
14 map entitled “Proposed Gunn McKay Nature Preserve”  
15 and dated March 2002, are hereby designated as the  
16 “Gunn McKay Nature Preserve”.

17 (b) **MANAGEMENT.**—

18 (1) **MANAGEMENT PLAN.**—Not later than 120  
19 days after the date of the enactment of this Act, the  
20 Secretary, in consultation with the City of Hunts-  
21 ville, Utah, and the Gunn McKay Nature Preserve  
22 Foundation, Inc., a nonprofit corporation, shall de-  
23 velop a management plan for the Preserve.

24 (2) **COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT.**—The Secretary  
25 is authorized to enter into a cooperative agreement

1 with the Gunn McKay Nature Preserve Foundation,  
2 Inc. for the management of the Preserve.

3 (c) WITHDRAWAL.—Subject to valid existing rights,  
4 the Preserve is hereby withdrawn from all forms of loca-  
5 tion, entry, and patent under the public land laws, and  
6 the mining and mineral leasing laws of the United States,  
7 including geothermal.
