Mr. HANSEN introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Resources

A BILL

To designate certain Federal lands in the State of Utah as the Gunn McKay Nature Preserve, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Gunn McKay Nature
5 Preserve Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. DEFINITIONS.**

7 For the purposes of this Act:

8 (1) PRESERVE.—The term “Preserve” means
9 the Gunn McKay Nature Preserve as so designated
10 by section 3(a).

1 (2) SECRETARY.—The term “Secretary” means
2 the Secretary of Agriculture.

3 **SEC. 3. NATURE PRESERVE.**

4 (a) DESIGNATION.—The approximately 15 acres of
5 National Forest System land generally depicted on the
6 map entitled “Proposed Gunn McKay Nature Preserve”
7 and dated March 2002, are hereby designated as the
8 “Gunn McKay Nature Preserve”.

9 (b) MANAGEMENT.—

10 (1) MANAGEMENT PLAN.—Not later than 120
11 days after the date of the enactment of this Act, the
12 Secretary, in consultation with the City of Hunts-
13 ville, Utah, and the Gunn McKay Nature Preserve
14 Foundation, Inc., a nonprofit corporation, shall de-
15 velop a management plan for the Preserve.

16 (2) COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT.—The Secretary
17 is authorized to enter into a cooperative agreement
18 with the Gunn McKay Nature Preserve Foundation,
19 Inc. for the management of the Preserve.

20 (c) WITHDRAWAL.—Subject to valid existing rights,
21 the Preserve is hereby withdrawn from all forms of loca-
22 tion, entry, and patent under the public land laws, and
23 the mining and mineral leasing laws of the United States,
24 including geothermal.
