## A BILL

To convert a temporary judgeship for the eastern district of Virginia to a permanent judgeship, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DISTRICT JUDGESHIP FOR THE EASTERN DIS-**  
4 **TRICT OF VIRGINIA.**

5 (a) CONVERSION OF TEMPORARY JUDGESHIP TO  
6 PERMANENT JUDGESHIP.—The existing district judgeship  
7 for the eastern district of Virginia authorized by section  
8 203(c) of the Judicial Improvements Act of 1990 (Public  
9 Law 101–650; 28 U.S.C. 133 note) shall, as of the date

1 of the enactment of this Act, be authorized under section  
2 133 of title 28, United States Code, and the incumbent  
3 in that office shall hold the office under section 133 of  
4 title 28, United States Code (as amended by this Act).

5 (b) TECHNICAL AND CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—

6 The table contained in section 133(a) of title 28, United  
7 States Code, is amended by striking the item relating to  
8 Virginia and inserting the following:

“Virginia:	
Eastern .....	11
Western .....	4”.
