A BILL

To increase, effective as of December 1, 2002, the rates

of disability compensation for veterans with service-connected disabilities and the rates of dependency and indemnity compensation for survivors of certain serviceconnected disabled veterans, and for other purposes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Veterans' and Survivors"
5 Benefits Expansion Act of 2002".

6 SEC. 2. INCREASE IN RATES OF DISABILITY COMPENSATION 7 AND DEPENDENCY AND INDEMNITY COM8 PENSATION.

9 (a) RATE ADJUSTMENT.—The Secretary of Veterans 10 Affairs shall, effective on December 1, 2002, increase the dol-11 lar amounts in effect for the payment of disability com-12 pensation and dependency and indemnity compensation by 13 the Secretary, as specified in subsection (b).

14 (b) AMOUNTS TO BE INCREASED.—The dollar
15 amounts to be increased pursuant to subsection (a) are the
16 following:

17 (1) COMPENSATION.—Each of the dollar amounts
18 in effect under section 1114 of title 38, United States
19 Code.

20 (2) ADDITIONAL COMPENSATION FOR DEPEND21 ENTS.—Each of the dollar amounts in effect under
22 sections 1115(1) of such title.

1	(3) CLOTHING ALLOWANCE.—The dollar amount
2	in effect under section 1162 of such title.
3	(4) New dic rates.—The dollar amounts in ef-
4	fect under paragraphs (1) and (2) of section $1311(a)$
5	of such title.
6	(5) OLD DIC RATES.—Each of the dollar
7	amounts in effect under section $1311(a)(3)$ of such
8	title.
9	(6) Additional dic for surviving spouses
10	WITH MINOR CHILDREN.—The dollar amount in effect
11	under section 1311(b) of such title.
12	(7) Additional dic for disability.—The dol-
13	lar amounts in effect under sections 1311(c) and
14	1311(d) of such title.
15	(8) DIC FOR DEPENDENT CHILDREN.—The dol-
16	lar amounts in effect under sections 1313(a) and
17	1314 of such title.
18	(c) Determination of Increase.—(1) The increase
19	under subsection (a) shall be made in the dollar amounts
20	specified in subsection (b) as in effect on November 30,
21	2002.
22	(2) Except as provided in paragraph (3), each such
23	amount shall be increased by the same percentage as the
24	percentage by which benefit amounts payable under title II
25	of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 401 et seq.) are in-

creased effective December 1, 2002, as a result of a deter mination under section 215(i) of such Act (42 U.S.C.
 415(i)).

4 (3) Each dollar amount increased pursuant to para5 graph (2) shall, if not a whole dollar amount, be rounded
6 down to the next lower whole dollar amount.

7 (d) SPECIAL RULE.—The Secretary may adjust ad8 ministratively, consistent with the increases made under
9 subsection (a), the rates of disability compensation payable
10 to persons within the purview of section 10 of Public Law
11 85–857 (72 Stat. 1263) who are not in receipt of compensa12 tion payable pursuant to chapter 11 of title 38, United
13 States Code.

(e) PUBLICATION OF ADJUSTED RATES.—At the same
time as the matters specified in section 215(i)(2)(D) of the
Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 415(i)(2)(D)) are required
to be published by reason of a determination made under
section 215(i) of such Act during fiscal year 2003, the Secretary of Veterans Affairs shall publish in the Federal Register the amounts specified in subsection (b), as increased
pursuant to that section.

1	SEC. 3. RETENTION OF DEPENDENCY AND INDEMNITY COM-
2	PENSATION FOR SURVIVING SPOUSES RE-
3	MARRYING AFTER AGE 65.
4	(a) Exception to Termination of Benefits Upon
5	Remarkinge.—Paragraph (2) of section 103(d) of title 38,
6	United States Code, is amended by striking "if the remar-
7	riage" and all that follows and inserting "if—
8	``(A) the remarriage occurs after the surviving
9	spouse attains age 65 ;
10	``(B) the remarriage has been terminated by
11	death; or
12	``(C) the remarriage has been terminated by di-
13	vorce, unless the Secretary determines that the divorce
14	was secured through fraud or collusion.".
15	(b) Conforming Amendments.—Paragraph (4) of
16	such section is amended—
17	(1) by striking "The first month" and all the fol-
18	lows through "shall be" and inserting the following
19	"When eligibility for benefits for a surviving spouse
20	is restored by reason of this subsection, the first
21	month of eligibility for such benefits shall be"; and
22	(2) in subparagraph (A), by striking "described
23	in" and inserting "with a remarriage described in
24	subparagraph (B) or (C) of".

(c) INCLUSION OF DEATH COMPENSATION AMONG RE STORED BENEFITS.—Subparagraph (A) of paragraph (5)
 of such section is amended to read as follows:

4 "(A) Sections 1121 and 1311, relating to death
5 compensation and dependency and indemnity com6 pensation, respectively.".

7 (d) Application for Benefits.—In the case of an 8 individual who but for having remarried would be eligible 9 for dependency and indemnity compensation under section 10 1311 of title 38, United States Code, or death compensation under section 1121 of such title, and whose remarriage was 11 before the date of the enactment of this Act and after the 12 individual had attained age 65, the individual shall be eli-13 gible for such compensation by reason of the amendments 14 15 made by subsection (a) only if the individual submits an application for such compensation to the Secretary of Vet-16 erans Affairs not later than the end of the one-year period 17 beginning on the date of the enactment of this Act. 18

(e) COORDINATION OF BENEFITS.—Section 1311 of
such title is amended by adding at the end the following
new subsection:

"(e) In the case of an individual who is eligible for dependency and indemnity compensation under this section by reason of section 103(d)(2)(A) of this title who is also eligible for benefits under another provision of law by reason of such individual's status as the surviving spouse of
 a veteran, then, notwithstanding any other provision of
 law, no reduction in benefits under such other provision of
 law shall be made by reason of such individual's eligibility
 for benefits under this section.".

10 (2) The amendment made by paragraph (1) shall 11 apply with respect to insurance payable under section 2106 12 of title 38, United States Code, in the case of a veteran 13 insured under that section who dies on or after the date 14 of enactment of this Act.
