A BILL

To support certain housing proposals in the fiscal year 2003 budget for the Federal Government, including the down-payment assistance initiative under the HOME Investment Partnerships Act, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 2 This Act may be cited as the "American Dream
- 3 Downpayment Act".
- 4 SEC. 2. DOWNPAYMENT ASSISTANCE INITIATIVE UNDER
- 5 HOME PROGRAM.
- 6 (a) Downpayment Assistance Initiative.—Sub-
- 7 title E of title II of the Cranston-Gonzalez National Af-
- 8 fordable Housing Act (42 U.S.C. 12821) is amended to
- 9 read as follows:

"Subtitle E—Other Assistance

- 11 "SEC. 271. DOWNPAYMENT ASSISTANCE INITIATIVE.
- 12 "(a) Grant Authority.—The Secretary may make
- 13 grants to participating jurisdictions to assist low-income
- 14 families to achieve homeownership, in accordance with this
- 15 section.
- 16 "(b) Eligible Activities.—Amounts made avail-
- 17 able under this section may be used only for downpayment
- 18 assistance toward the purchase of single family housing
- 19 by low-income families who are first-time homebuyers. For
- 20 purposes of this title, the term 'downpayment assistance'
- 21 means assistance to help a family acquire a principal resi-
- 22 dence.
- 23 "(c) Housing Strategy.—To be eligible to receive
- 24 a grant under this section for a fiscal year, a participating
- 25 jurisdiction shall include in its comprehensive housing af-

- 1 fordability strategy under section 105 for such year a de-
- 2 scription of the use of the grant amounts.
- 3 "(d) FORMULA ALLOCATION.—For each fiscal year,
- 4 the Secretary shall allocate any amounts made available
- 5 for assistance under this section for the fiscal year in ac-
- 6 cordance with a formula, which shall be established by the
- 7 Secretary, that considers a participating jurisdiction's
- 8 need for and prior commitment to assistance to home-
- 9 buyers. The formula may include minimum and maximum
- 10 allocation amounts.
- 11 "(e) Reallocation.—If any amounts allocated to a
- 12 participating jurisdiction under this section become avail-
- 13 able for reallocation, the amounts shall be reallocated to
- 14 other participating jurisdictions in accordance with the
- 15 formula established pursuant to subsection (c), except that
- 16 if a local participating jurisdiction failed to receive
- 17 amounts allocated under this section and is located in a
- 18 State that is a participating jurisdiction, the funds shall
- 19 be reallocated to the State.
- 20 "(f) Applicability of Other Provisions.—
- 21 "(1) In General.—Except as otherwise pro-
- vided in this section, grants under this section shall
- 23 not be subject to the provisions of this title.
- 24 "(2) APPLICABLE PROVISIONS.—In addition to
- 25 the requirements of this section, grants under this

- section shall be subject to the provisions of title I,
 sections 215(b), 218, 219, 221, 223, 224, and
 226(a) of subtitle A of this title, and subtitle F of
 this title.

 "(3) References.—In applying the requirements of subtitle A referred to in paragraph (2)—
 "(A) any references to funds under subtitle
- A shall be considered to refer to amounts made available for assistance under this section; and "(B) any references to funds allocated or reallocated under section 217 or 217(d) shall be considered to refer to amounts allocated or reallocated under subsection (d) or (e) of this section, respectively.
- "(g) ADMINISTRATIVE COSTS.—Notwithstanding section 212(c), a participating jurisdiction may use funds under subtitle A for administrative and planning costs of the jurisdiction in carrying out this section, and the limitation in section 212(c) shall be based on the total amount of funds available under subtitle A and this section.
- 21 "(h) Funding.—
- "(1) FISCAL YEAR 2002.—This section constitutes the subsequent legislation authorizing the Downpayment Assistance Initiative referred to in the item relating to the 'HOME Investment Partner-

- ships Program' in title II of the Departments of
- 2 Veterans Affairs and Housing and Urban Develop-
- ment, and Independent Agencies Appropriations Act,
- 4 2002 (Public Law 107–73; 115 Stat. 666).
- 5 "(2) Subsequent fiscal years.—There is
- 6 authorized to be appropriated to carry out this sec-
- 7 tion \$200,000,000 for each of fiscal years 2003
- 8 through 2006.".
- 9 (b) Relocation Assistance and Downpayment
- 10 Assistance.—Subtitle F of title II of the Cranston-Gon-
- 11 zalez National Affordable Housing Act is amended by in-
- 12 serting after section 290 (42 U.S.C. 12840) the following
- 13 new section:
- 14 "SEC. 291. RELOCATION ASSISTANCE AND DOWNPAYMENT
- 15 ASSISTANCE.
- 16 "The Uniform Relocation Assistance and Real Prop-
- 17 erty Acquisition Policies Act of 1970 shall not apply to
- 18 downpayment assistance under this title.".
- 19 SEC. 3. REAUTHORIZATION OF SHOP PROGRAM.
- 20 Section 11(p) of the Housing Opportunity Program
- 21 Extension Act of 1996 (42 U.S.C. 12805 note) is amended
- 22 by striking "such sums as may be necessary for fiscal year
- 23 2001" and inserting "\$65,000,000 for fiscal year 2003
- 24 and such sums as may be necessary for fiscal year 2004".
