Ms. MCCARTHY of Missouri introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Ways and Means

## A BILL

To provide for the liquidation or reliquidation of certain entries.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. CERTAIN ENTRIES OF POSTERS.**

4       (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding section 514 of  
5       the Tariff Act of 1930 (19 U.S.C. 1514) or any other pro-  
6       vision of law and subject to the provisions of subsection  
7       (b), the United States Customs Service shall—

8               (1) not later than 90 days after the receipt of  
9       the request described in subsection (b), liquidate or  
10       reliquidate each entry described in subsection (c)  
11       containing any merchandise which, at the time of

1 the original liquidation, was classified under sub-  
 2 heading 4911.91.20 of the Harmonized Tariff  
 3 Schedule of the United States at the rate of duty  
 4 that would have been applicable to such merchandise  
 5 if the merchandise had been liquidated or reliq-  
 6 uidated under subheading 4911.91.40 of the Har-  
 7 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States on the  
 8 date of entry; and

9 (2) within 90 days after such liquidation or  
 10 reliquidation—

11 (A) refund any excess duties paid with re-  
 12 spect to such entries, including interest from  
 13 the date of entry; or

14 (B) relieve the importer of record of any  
 15 excess duties, penalties, or fines associated with  
 16 the excess duties.

17 (b) REQUESTS.—Reliquidation may be made under  
 18 subsection (a) with respect to any entry described in sub-  
 19 section (c) only if a request therefor is filed with the Cus-  
 20 toms Service within 90 days after the date of the enact-  
 21 ment of this Act.
