## A BILL

To reduce temporarily the duty on NMSBA.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. NMSBA.**

4 (a) CALENDAR YEAR 2003.—

5 (1) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99  
6 of the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United  
7 States is amended by inserting in numerical se-  
8 quence the following new heading:

“	9902.29.82	4- (Methylsulfonyl)- 2-nitrobenzoic acid (CAS No. 110964-79-9) (provided for in subheading 2916.39.45) .....	0.28%	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2003	”.

1           (2) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made  
2 by paragraph (1) applies with respect to goods en-  
3 tered, or withdrawn from warehouse for consump-  
4 tion, on or after the 15th day after the date of the  
5 enactment of this Act.

6           (b) CALENDAR YEAR 2004.—

7           (1) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.29.82, as  
8 added by subsection (a), is amended—

9                   (A) by striking “0.28%” and inserting  
10 “0.16%”; and

11                   (B) by striking “On or before 12/31/2003”  
12 and inserting “On or before 12/31/2004”.

13           (2) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made  
14 by paragraph (1) shall take effect on January 1,  
15 2004.

16           (c) CALENDAR YEARS 2005 THROUGH 2007.—

17           (1) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.29.82, as  
18 added by subsection (a) and amended by subsection  
19 (b), is further amended—

20                   (A) by striking “0.16%” and inserting  
21 “1.1%”; and

22                   (B) by striking “On or before 12/31/2004”  
23 and inserting “On or before 12/31/2007”.

1           (2) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made  
2           by paragraph (1) shall take effect on January 1,  
3           2005.
