3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "No Frills Prison Act5 of 2001".

6 SEC. 2. PROHIBITION OF CERTAIN LUXURIES IN FEDERAL 7 PRISONS.

8 Section 4007 of title 18, United States Code, is
9 amended by adding at the end the following: "Money from
10 the Treasury of the United States shall not be used to

purchase cable television services, to rent or purchase vid eocassettes, videocassette recorders, or other audiovisual
 or electronic equipment used primarily for recreational
 purposes. The preceding sentence does not preclude the
 rental or purchase of audiovisual or electronic equipment
 for inmate training or educational programs.".
