- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Disabled Veterans"
- 5 Caregiver Compensation Act".

1	SEC. 2. ADDITIONAL COMPENSATION FOR DISABLED VET-
2	ERANS IN NEED OF REGULAR AID AND AT-
3	TENDANCE WHO HAVE DEPENDENT FAMILY
4	MEMBER CAREGIVERS.
5	Section 1115 of title 38, United States Code, is
6	amended by adding at the end the following new para-
7	graph:
8	"(3) If and while rated totally disabled and in
9	need of regular aid and attendance and while unpaid
10	aid and attendance is provided by an adult family
11	member who is dependent upon such veteran for
12	support, \$234.''.
